The Season of Lent Begins

February 14th



Lent is the penitential time of prayer, fasting, almsgiving and personal sacrifice meant to draw Christians more deeply into the sacred mystery of the Lord's Passion, Death and

Resurrection.

During Lent, the Church calls the faithful to bring a spirit of penance into their lives through fasting and abstinence.

Fasting requires that only one full meal with two, smaller meals to maintain physical strength, Fasting is an obligation of Catholics from age 18 to 59.

Abstinence prohibits the eating of meat on a particular day. Abstinence is an obligation for all Catholics beginning at age 14 and continuing throughout life. **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence.**

Enhanced Star Tax Benefits for Senior Citizens



If you are 65 or older, you should be aware that there is a senior exemption that may reduce your property tax bill if you qualify. This exemption has different income limits than Basic star.

Deadline to register is March 1st for people 65 or turning 65 in 2018. You must contact your local assessor's office to file the paperwork.
