**Divine Mercy Novena**

On Good Friday, 1937, in one of a series of apparitions to Sr. Faustina Kowalska, a nun in the Congregation of Our Lady of Mercy in Poland, Our Lord asked her to undertake a special novena invoking his Father’s mercy. That novena was to start that day (Good Friday) and continue for nine consecutive days ending on the Sunday after Easter. Jesus dictated to her each day’s intention. Pamphlets containing the novena, along with the Chaplet of Mercy that accompanies it, are in the rear of the Church. Please pick one up and pray it, it started Good Friday. At St. Peter’s, we will conclude the novena with a Divine Mercy Service after the 10am Mass on April 8th. It will consist of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, a period of silent adoration, benediction and blessing of our new Divine Mercy image.
